1. Introduction

This Cookie Policy explains how Alignex uses cookies and similar technologies on Alignex.pro. It outlines what cookies are, which types may be used, and how users can control their use.

Cookies will only be placed on a user's device if permitted by applicable law and based on the user's selected preferences.

2. Definition of Cookies

B. Performance and Analytics Cookies

These cookies are only activated if you provide consent.

Legal Basis: Consent

These cookies allow the website to remember user preferences, such as language settings or interface configurations, to enhance the browsing experience.

These cookies are only activated if you provide consent.

D. [Third-Party Cookies](#)

Status: Optional (Consent Required)

Legal Basis: Consent

Some services integrated into the website may use cookies provided by third parties. These cookies track a user's browsing history and activities, which can be utilized by third parties. These may include analytics providers, embedded content services, or security tools.
